# CADET WEEK 2012

#### Monday 20th Aug - Fri 24th Aug

Dear Cadets and Parents,

Please find enclosed the registration forms for Cadet Week 2012.

Forms with the TBYC logo should be posted into the club letterbox with payment.

Forms with the Purple Chilli logo should be returned to the Purple Chilli kitchen team with payment.

#### This year there will be 5 groups, as follows:

#### STINGRAYS - Leader: Mark Petty-Mayor

This group is mainly for beginners and those who do not wish to take part in structured courses or races. The emphasis will be on having fun. Minimum age those starting infant school September 2012 (children need to be happy around the water). <u>Maximum 40 cadets</u>.

#### PIRANHAS - Leader: Scott Weller

This group is to enable the transition from Stingrays to Barracudas, with activities designed to develop confidence on the water and basic seamanship. All cadets in this group must have completed Stage 1 and/or be regular participants in either the T.O.P. series or club racing.

Maximum 20 cadets (15 boats).

#### BARRACUDAS - Leader: Mike Thomason

This group will be doing general seamanship skills and sail training with some racing. All cadets in this group must have completed Stage 2 and/or be regular participants in either the T.O.P. series or club racing. Maximum 40 cadets (20 boats). All in Picos 2 up

#### SHARKS - Leader: Chris Pimm

This group is for older cadets who are confident sailors, but who do not want to race every day, or older cadets without experience (but with confidence) who are paired with a more experienced sailor. They will be expected to be sailing in socially compatible pairs (unless the boat is a single-hander) and will practise boat handling, have fun races and explore the estuary.

#### RACE GROUP - Leaders: Rupert Snow/Steve Hopper

This group is for cadets in Y7 or above who are competent sailors and want to enter a week long race series (with training opportunities between races).

There will be 3 classes: Fevas, Picos (2-up) and Handicap classes (open to any dinghy). This group will sail for trophies in each fleet as well as an overall handicap trophy. Races will be mass start and will use different course structures each day to ensure parity.

#### Meals

This year all lunches are included from the Monday to the Friday. Evening meals will also be provided, however, we will not be providing food or entertainment on the Thursday due to the later tides (Purple Chilli Catering will be providing food on an adhoc basis in the evening should parents wish to purchase this before leaving the club).

Extra evening meals required for parents and brothers/sisters not taking part in Cadet Week are available by filling out the attached form.

This year if parents would like a roll/sandwich made up for lunchtime for themselves these can be ordered for £10 for the week and will be delivered to the Bosun's hut. (Please note crisps and chocolate bars are not included - they are for the cadets!)

Please note sandwiches must be paid <u>for in advance to Purple Chilli Catering</u>, filling in the attached forms and returning with the registration form.

#### Fees

The price of Cadet Week 2012 is £75.00. This maintains the price for the third year running (despite costs rising in all areas) thanks to a review of feedback from the recent meetings and sponsorships secured. Due to the expected demand there will be no refunds for late cancellation or for those attending only part of the week.

Please send your cheque, made payable to TBYC with your registration form, by no later than Friday 25<sup>th</sup> May 2012. Please ensure that envelopes are addressed to CadetWeek 2012 c/o TBYC. If you are not posting your form, please put it in the mail box which is situated by the front doors of the Clubhouse. Please do not leave any application forms behind the bar.

#### **Evening Events**

- Monday; we will be having a BBQ (served from the Bosun's Hut) and, weather permitting, team games will be played on the beach...bring a deck-chair and enjoy the atmosphere.
- Tuesday; we have our annual visit to Adventure Island after dinner at the club. Tickets for the participating cadets are included in the price of Cadet Week; make sure you book any extra tickets for the theme-park on the form attached.
- Wednesday; younger cadets have a private party and dinner at Kids Kingdom whilst those at Senior School will have an evening meal and karaoke at the Gold Coast.
- Thursday; due to the late tides there are no planned activities at the club, as outlined above, food can be purchased separately from Purple Chill Catering.
- Friday; Prize-giving will be held after dinner at the club for all.

Please see separate sheet for more details of these events. The sailing timetable for the week will be available nearer the time.

#### ALL PARENTS

Thank you to those parents who volunteered at the feedback sessions. Please can you and any additional parents fill in the attached form letting us know how you can help during Cadet Week. The week really does depend on your support and you are reminded that your children <u>must be accompanied by an adult at all times</u>. If your child is taking part in Cadet Week then at least one parent is required to help out in some way.

Please also make sure your children sign in and out each day.

Places for Stingrays, Piranhas will be allocated on a first come first served basis as these are novice groups by definition. Places in both Barracudas and the Racing Group will be at the discretion of the Cadet Committee and will take into account regular sailing activity in both the TOP Series and/or Club racing and attendance at Thursday Cadet Nights if the demand for places exceeds the maximum numbers given.
