Race Notice & Supplementary Sailing Instructions Shoreline Trophy Race - Sunday 28 April 2013

Rules: Racing will be governed by the Thorpe Bay Yacht Club 2012 Sailing Instructions (see club web-site and/or notice board) as amended by this Notice.

Start time: 1300hrs.

High water: 15.06hrs.

Mass start club trophy race

Warning flag: International code flag R

Committee Boat start

TBYC Distance Mark/Shorebox Finish

The Course

Course marks - Marks A, B, C, D and E will be orange or yellow cylindrical inflatable marks. The West Shoebury buoy is a green conical mark located to the east of Southend Pier and the Leigh buoy is a green conical mark located to the west of Southend Pier. The TBYC Distance Mark is a pole south of the TBYC slipway and includes the East and West marks either side of it. Mark B will be located approximately south of the Halfway House pub. The Pier Head is the southern end of Southend-on-Sea Pier. Mark C will be located approximately south of Chalkwell Station. Mark D will be located approximately south of the TEYC clubhouse at No3 The Leas in Chalkwell. Mark E will be located approximately south of the Alexandra Yacht Club clubhouse. The TBYC Committee Boat is white/green catamaran.

Course – Mark A. West Shoebury Buoy to port. TBYC Distance Mark to port. Mark B to port. Pier Head to starboard. Leigh Buoy to starboard. Mark C to starboard. Mark D to starboard. Mark E to starboard. Pier Head to port. Mark B to starboard. Finish West to East on the TBYC shore box line.

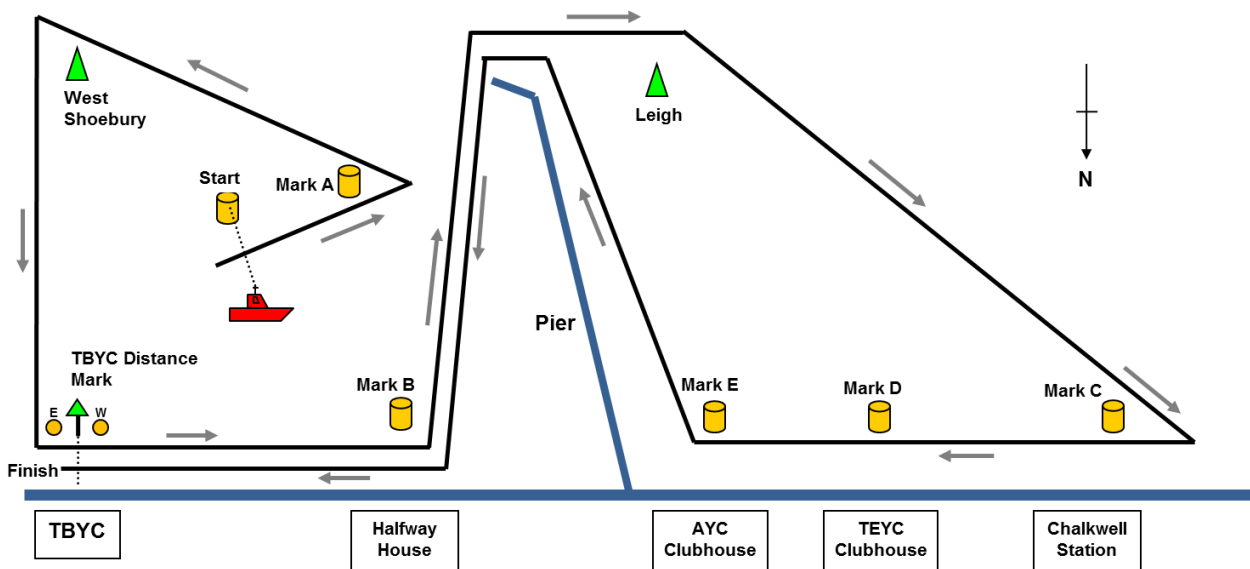


Diagram is for indicative purposes only and is not to scale. Mark A is the intended windward mark. The direction of the leg from the start line to Mark A, and the direction of rounding of Mark A, will be set according to wind direction.

Mark A will be positioned approximately to windward of the start line. The direction of rounding of Mark A will be shown by displaying a green or red flag on the Committee Boat before the Warning signal: red means round Mark A to port, green means round Mark A to starboard.

Prize-giving: Prizes will be awarded at the discretion of the sailing committee, plus the Shoreline Trophy to the overall winner and the National Westminster Trophy to the first placed helm under 25 years of age on the day of the race. Prize-giving will take place at the end of season Prize-giving on Saturday 17 November.
