



SAILING INSTRUCTIONS 2019

SSI amendments 2019 – additional – changes in *italics*

2.1 Eligibility

Races will be open to Club members and approved affiliates only. Any helmsman signing the declaration form and sailing a race will be deemed to have entered the series.

2.1a A change of class or sail configuration within that class will be treated as a separate entry for the series

2.1b *A change of sail, spars, hull or appendages shall not be deemed as a separate entry for the series*

2.1c *For 2 (or more) handed boats crew may be substituted within a series, this will not be treated as a separate entry so long as 1 of the original crew entered in the series remains onboard.*

9.3 The Course – Mass start

For a Mass Start (Trophy Races and Midweek Series) the same course must be sailed by all competitors.

A Port handed Course must be used.

13.2 Finishing Line – Committee Boat Start

Unless otherwise specified the finishing line will be as for the start line and may be shortened after the start

13.3 Boats that have finished must, as far as practicable, keep clear of the finish line.

13.4 *Cadets may be identified by a chequered ribbon affixed to the head of their mainsail*

13.5 Cadets may, at the Race Committee discretion have their course shortened and finished at any
