Rules: Racing will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions of the RYA, the class rules, except if any of these are changed by these sailing instructions, the Thorpe Bay Yacht Club Sailing Instructions and these Supplementary Sailing Instructions.

Eligibility and Entry: The regatta is open to boats of all classes. Non Members of Thorpe Bay Yacht Club may enter by completing an entry form available from the website and handed in at the clubhouse main bar area prior to racing.

Fees: There will be no Entry fee.

Briefing: there will be a briefing at 8:45am on Saturday.

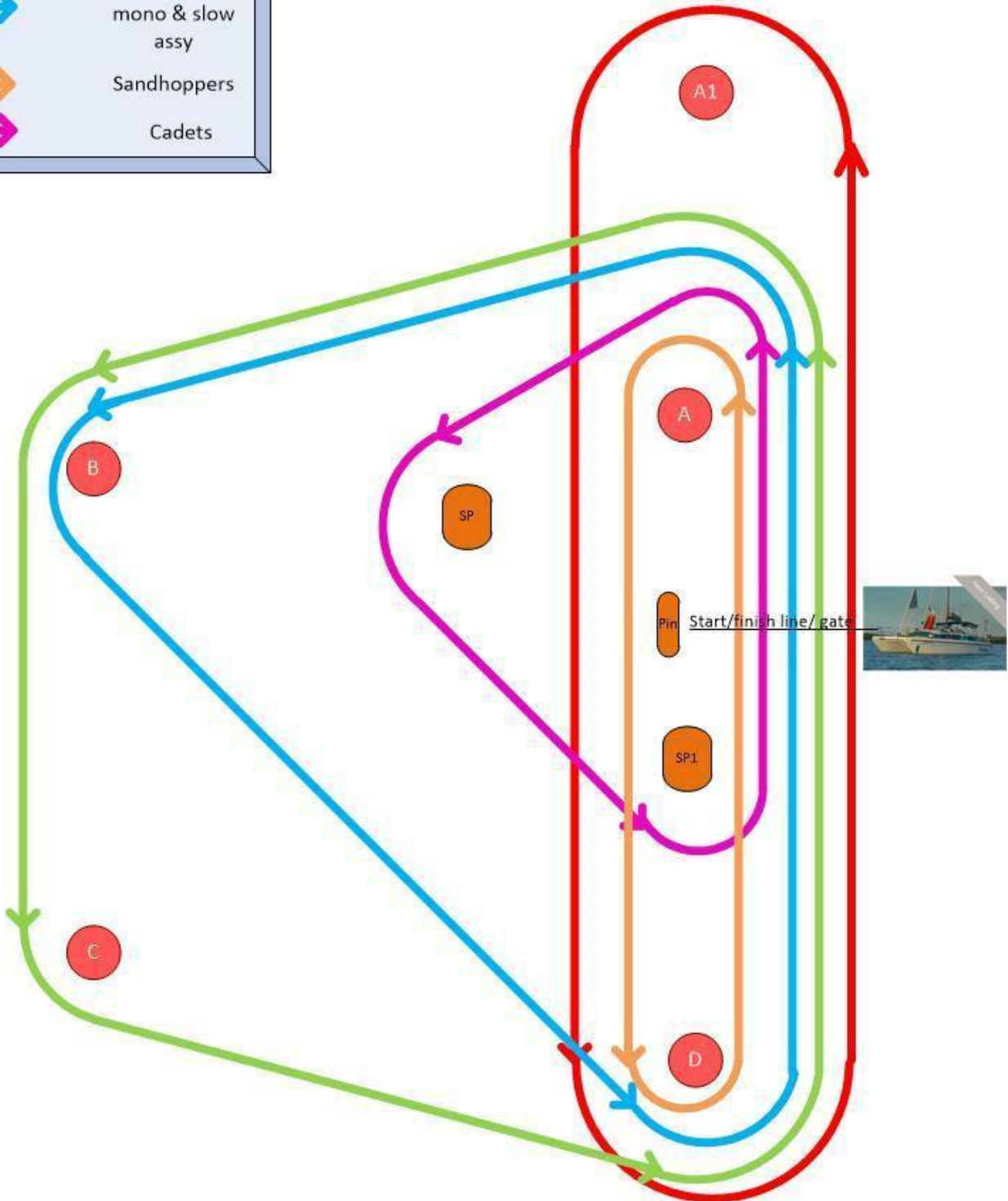

Fast Asymmetric Monohull, Fast Asymmetric multihull, foiling moths:

A1 (Port), D (Port), gate

Sprints and Multihulls:

A (port), B (port), C (port), D (port), gate

Monohull:

A (port), B (port), D (port), gate

Sandhoppers

A (port), D (port), gate

Cadets

A (port), DP (port), SP1 (port), gate

Sailing Instructions: These are the standard TBYC sailing Instructions and will be available in the clubhouse main bar area on completion of registration or from the club website.

Scoring: will be the low point system. Each boat's series score shall be the total of her race scores, with her worst score discarded if four races have been completed. If three or fewer races are completed, a boat's score will be the total of her race scores.

Disclaimer of Liability: Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta.

Insurance: Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance with a minimum of £2,000,000 per event.

Boat Parking: Boats should be left in the TBYC boat park fronting on to Thorpe Esplanade or as directed by a member of the event organising team. In the event of the boat park being full, boats will be left at the south side of the overflow car park to the east of the dinghy park. Road trailers are to be left either under boats or to the east side of the overflow car park.

Car Parking: Cars should be parked in the Southend Corporation Car Park adjacent to the boat park – TBYC car parking stickers will be made available or an area will be roped off, access will be via the dinghy park. No cars in the boat park please.

Accommodation: No Camping in the corporation car park next to the Dinghy Park. Local B&Bs and Hotels are available. No cars in the boat park please.

Food and Bar Service: Food and drink will be available in the clubhouse on both days. Menus and specials boards will be on display in the clubhouse main bar area along with the times that food will be served. Saturday Night there will be beer and live music in the clubhouse.

Prizes: Prizes will be awarded to the first 3 boats in each fleet.

Prize-giving: In the clubhouse as soon as possible after completion of racing on Sunday.

Changes to Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions: All changes will be posted at least two hours before the start of the race it will affect, except that any change in the schedule of races will be posted by 20.00 on the day before it will take effect.
