

# TBYC NOTICE TO MEMBERS BACK TO RACING

TBYC is pleased to be able to return to racing. However, it is your choice, your decision, your responsibility and do so at your own risk. The General Committee requests that you follow the rules below to maintain the safety to all members.

## General Rules and Guidance for Returning to Racing

- Please observe social distancing at all times. Do not go within 2 meters without mitigation
- Please avoid touching common surfaces and regularly wash your hands
- Please cover your mouths and nose when sneezing or coughing
- Please proceed around the dinghy park car park beach and slipway with caution and consideration to others
- Do not be afraid to ask another member 'to keep their distance', but always do so politely and with consideration so they will not be offended
- If the number of people becomes a risk, then restrictions may apply. This will only be introduced if absolutely necessary and only to protect our members
- If you or anyone from your household or anyone you have had contact with are showing symptoms of Covid 19 do not come to the club or dinghy park but follow Government guidelines self-isolating for 14 days
- Whilst we will have installed areas to wash your hands to assist you in keeping safe. We remind you that you are at your own risk entirely and further recommend you carry your own PPE and hygiene supplies
- Do not share water or fill from the hoses or sinks to further reduce the risk of transmission

## On the Water Guidance

- All applicable TBYC rules still apply
- Check your equipment to ensure it is fit to go afloat
- If possible, take a method of communication with you; ship to shore radio if you have one or your mobile phone. Making sure there is sufficient battery life on your device for the time afloat. Take both if you have them.  
Wetsuit Outlet have supplied the club with waterproof phone cases for your use.
- The Risk Assessment associated with returning to racing is available on the club website. It is essential that you read this particularly if you are part of the race or safety boat teams.
- By entering a race, you are deemed to have read and understood the requirements in the Risk Assessment.
- The club requests that all non-racers keep clear of all launch areas 30 minutes before the published start times.

## Racing Guidance /Amendments

- All racing will now take place from the Committee Boat, using the fixed club marks and 1 start mark.
- Fleet start times will be as usual.
- 2 points races per day will be run. This may change at short notice to accommodate trophy races.

- All racing will be reviewed on a regular basis and this notice and Risk Assessment may change
