Rules: Racing will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions of the RYA, the class rules, except if any of these are changed by these sailing instructions, the Thorpe Bay Yacht Club Sailing Instructions and these Supplementary Sailing Instructions.

Eligibility and Entry: The regatta is open to boats of all classes. Non Members of Thorpe Bay Yacht Club may enter by completing an entry form available from the website and handed in at the clubhouse main bar area prior to racing.

Fees: There will be no Entry fee.

Briefing: there will be a briefing at **9am** on Saturday. This will be held in the car park in front of the clubhouse.



Courses: The course shall be in the Thames Estuary to the south of the clubhouse, bounded by the coastguard station to the east, the shipping channel to the south and the pier to the west.

The course configuration will change each day between: Windward / Leeward, and a Trapezoid. The course will be chosen on the day and displayed on the black board prior to the start. The passing marks will be displayed on the Rear of the Committee Boat. All boats will do the same course.

Note: Windward / Leeward Course

There will be a spreader mark approx. 30 yards on from the windward mark as shown. This will be signified on the committee boat as Sp. All marks to Port. No boat will cross the start line on the downwind leg.



Trapezoid Course:

A, B, C, D - as per club standard SI's

All boats will pass through the start - finish line on the completion of each lap. The race will finish when Code Flag S is flown with two sound signals. Fleets may be separated and average lap times will be used.



Sailing Instructions: These are the standard TBYC sailing Instructions and will be available in the clubhouse main bar area on completion of registration of from the club website.

Scoring: will be the low point system. Each boat's series score shall be the total of her race scores. 1 discard will apply if four races have been sailed. 4 races to count for the series. (If less than 4 races are held due to adverse weather, the number of races to complete the series will be decided by the race committee.)

Disclaimer of Liability: Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta.

Insurance: Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance with a minimum of £2,000,000 per event.

Boat Parking: Boats should be left in the TBYC boat park fronting on to Thorpe Esplanade or as directed by a member of the event organising team.

Car Parking: Cars should be parked in the Southend Corporation Car Park adjacent to the boat park – TBYC car parking stickers will be made available. Access will be via the dinghy park.

Prizes: There will be prizes for the winner of the Catamaran Class and Monohull Class. The 2023 Regatta winner will be from the combined fleets results and will receive the TBYC Regatta Trophy. A prize also will be awarded to the winner of each class with the same 4 or more boats entered on both days and to the 1st placed cadet member.

Prize-giving: In the clubhouse as soon as possible after completion of racing on Sunday.

Changes to Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions: All changes will be posted at least two hours before the start of the race it will affect, except that any change in the schedule of races will be posted by 20.00 on the day before it will take effect.
