
Supplementary Sailing Instructions

(To the TBYC 2023 Sailing Instructions)

<u>Schedule</u>

There will be 2 start times.

Monohulls and Cats (incl Cadets) with PY> 865 Start Time 13:30 – 3rd Sub





This is a safety recommendation so that the majority of the fleet are crossing the channel at a similar time and our SS boats can be best placed.

The Start/Finish & Course

Committee boat start – The final course will be on the black board and will include: Lee Buoy (P), Large inflatable buoy(P) positioned just to the north of where the Yantlet Beacon used to be, Leigh Buoy (S)

All Cadets (17yrs under) Final course will be on the blackboard and may be a separate race and may not be crossing the Channel.

Shore Box Finish – The Finish will be at the shore box using the usual club line.

Crossing the Shipping Lanes

All competitors are reminded of the Regulations for the Prevention of Collision at Sea and in particular that ships in the channels will have restricted ability to manoeuvre or are constrained by draught and therefore have priority over sailing vessels. Keep a look out for ships in the shipping lanes and pass well astern. Plan and alter your course accordingly.
